FIRST QUARTER CASHFLOW REPORT


Admiralty Resources NL (**Admiralty**) is pleased to submit its quarterly cash flow report in the form of Appendix 5B for the period ended 30 September 2009.

Admiralty's cash balance as at 30 September 2009 was approximately \$483,000.

Admiralty had negative net cash flows from operating activities during the period of approximately \$1,447,000, however, the Board of Directors are of the opinion that Admiralty's future income will be able to meet the Company's cash flow and working capital requirements for the next 12 months.

Subsequent to the date of this report, the Company has begun receiving cash inflows from the sale of waste and low grade reject stockpiles and is currently completing a rights issue which will raise in excess of \$5 million.


